



CFE Roll Saw

The CFE Roll Saw is a saw mainly used in the paper- and converting industry to salvage damaged rolls; for example rolls damaged in handling or storing, or rolls with a moisture damage, so called "elephant foot". Due to the type of damage, these rolls can normally not be rewound. With the roll saw, the damaged part can be cut off and the remaining roll can be reused.

The roll saw can also be used when there is a need to divide a roll which is too wide for the converting process, i.e. rewinder, sheetcutter, etc.
